- The Potomac Valley District will again be the center piece for the 2014 3x3 National Championships hosted by Hoop It Up, USA Basketball and FIBA. Last year's games were held inside the Gaylord Hotel and Convention center and had international teams in a battle with the u18 USA Boys and Girls National teams.
